Accommodation

Transportation

Public transport in the Rouen Normandy metropolitan area offers quick access to the campuses and Rouen city centre.

In Rouen, from the Rouen Rive-Droite train station, you can take a direct train to Paris or various other towns in Normandy.

VISA requirements

Non E.U. students will need a VISA **and/or** a residence permit. Please contact your local French Embassy for more information about VISA requirements.

Health insurance

E.U. students in possession of a European Health Insurance Card (CEAM) will not be required to register to the French Health Insurance system.

E.U. students who do not have an European Health Insurance Card and **non E.U. students** will be required to register with the Caisse Primaire d'Assurance Maladie (CPAM) upon their registration at the University.
