With over 32,000 students and 38 research units, the **University of Rouen Normandy (URN)** plays a leading role in both teaching and research in Normandy. We are involved in regional teaching and research clusters, and promote interregional research activities by developing nationally and internationally renowned scientific partnerships. We therefore partake in numerous international projects in partnership with over 50 countries.

As a multidisciplinary institution, URN is particularly devoted to making higher education accessible to all and fostering local economic and social development.

We have 7 campuses in Normandy, with a total of 12 faculties, institutes and schools.

The Greater Rouen area is a great place to live, offering a wealth of heritage, culture and sports activities, as well as being a dynamic economic hub. Only an hour from the coast and an hour and a half from Paris by train, the University of Rouen Normandy is ideally situated.

Accomodation

Transportation

Public transport in the Rouen Normandy metropolitan area offers quick access to the campuses and Rouen city centre.

In Rouen, from the Rouen Rive-Droite train station, you can take a direct train to Paris or various other towns in Normandy.

VISA requirements

Non E.U. students will need a VISA **and/or** a residence permit. Please contact your local French Embassy for more information about VISA requirements.

Health insurance

<u>E.U. students</u> in possession of a European Health Insurance Card (CEAM) will not be required to register to the French Health Insurance system.

E.U. students who do not have an European Health Insurance Card and <u>non</u>

<u>E.U. students</u> will be required to register with the Caisse Primaire d'Assurance

Maladie (CPAM) upon their registration at the University.

Our campuses are equipped with a wireless internet connection, student restaurants and cafeterias, student libraries and a sports center.






