

COST OF LIVING IN FLENSBURG

The cost of living is generally slightly lower than in major German cities. Students are recommended to budget for a minimum of 850 € to 950 € monthly, including rent. Breakfast, lunch and snacks are available in the main campus refectory (*Mensa*) open on weekdays from 8:30 to 4:00. The menu includes daily vegetarian dishes.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION for NON-EU STUDENTS – You all need a STUDENT VISA to study in GERMANY

- All Non-EU students (including students from USA, Brazil and Korea) are required to get a
 STUDENT visa to be able to enter the country as a student and to open bank accounts in
 Germany. This is new.
- All non-EU students need to have a local bank account to be able to do payments, bank transfers, receive scholarships, etc.
- We recommend the students ask for an appointment to request visa at the time of nomination. In some countries is taking 3 months to get an appointment and the visa may take some weeks.
