

STUDENT EXCHANGE

A student can be nominated to come to KTU:

- O when valid bilateral agreement between home university and KTU exists;
- O under academic exchange programmes between countries.

Nomination should be done $\underline{\text{online}}$.

After the nomination, a unique link is sent to a student to start application procedure.

Documents you will need

Learning agreement:

- O Online learning agreement for Erasmus+ exchange;
- O Learning agreement for other exchange programmes.

Transcript of records:

O English language proficiency certificate (CEFR B2+, IELTS 5.5+, TOEFL IBT 70+ or equivalent).

Copy of valid passport (for non EU citizens or ID card (only for EU and EEA citizens).

Students are only allowed to write their final thesis if they have already found a supervisor at KTU on their own.


