Language of instruction	Spanish and English
	Most of the courses given at ETSIT-UPM at Bachelor level are in Spanish while a wide range of courses a Master level are available in English. It is advisable to have a Spanish language level equivalent to at least A2/B1 (Common European Framework of Reference for languages). If following classes in English, the minimum of English level required is B2. No certificate is required; when signing the learning agreement, the home Institution guarantees that the student has sufficient language knowledge in order to follow courses and pass exams. In some cases, a Spanish certificate may be required to the student.
