<b>Civil liability insurance</b>	<p>Exchange students should subscribe to a civil liability insurance policy which guarantees the repair of damages that may be caused by the student to a third person, to possessions for which they are legally responsible, or to their accommodation, regardless of whether the damages were caused through negligence or not. We strongly advise that students take out this insurance before arriving in Romania.</p>
