ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Nomination Deadline (compulsory)	First semester (Autumn semester) or full academic year: April 1st - June 30th Second semester (Spring semester): October 1st - November 30th

Nomination will include the following information	Name and surname; ID/passport number; date of birth; gender, e-mail address; exchange period requested and study field	
Online registration (compulsory)	After the nomination, the student will receive an email with a link to do the online application .	
Documents the student should upload to the online application before your arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning agreement • Copy of ID or passport • Required insurance document • European Insurance Card (if possible) 	
Deadline for online registration by the students (compulsory)	First semester (Autumn semester) or full academic year: May 1st - July 15th Second semester (Spring semester): November 1st - December 15th

	Classes: September/December Exam period: January	Classes: End of January – May Exam period: May/June
	Students can have a second exam in an extraordinary period (June/July)	
Buddy Program	Students will have a local student (buddy) to help to the exchange student.	
Preferred semester for receiving incoming students	Both semesters are acceptable, provided that the student finds a suitable program equivalent to 30 ECTS credits/semester.
