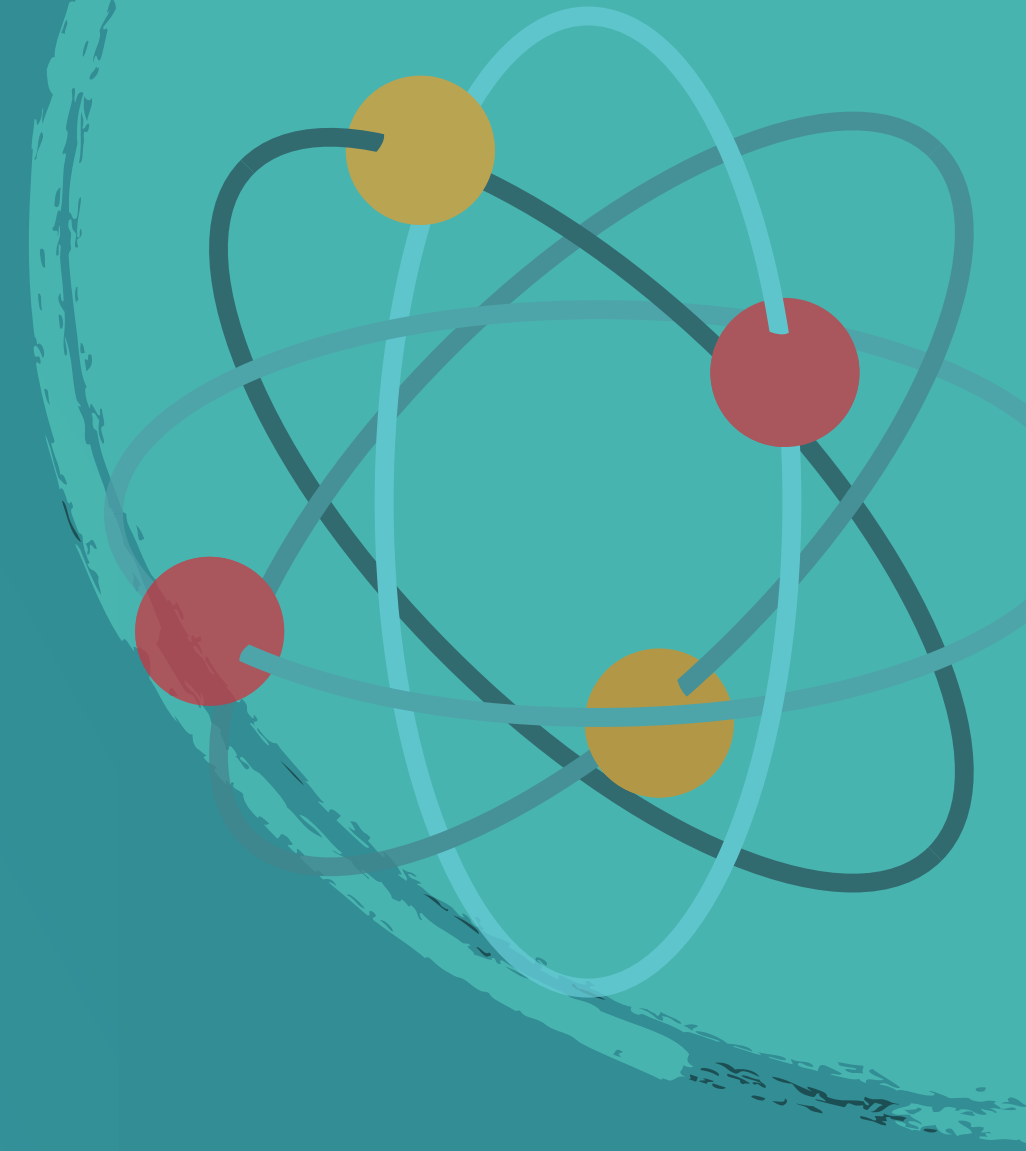

WHY OLSZTYN?

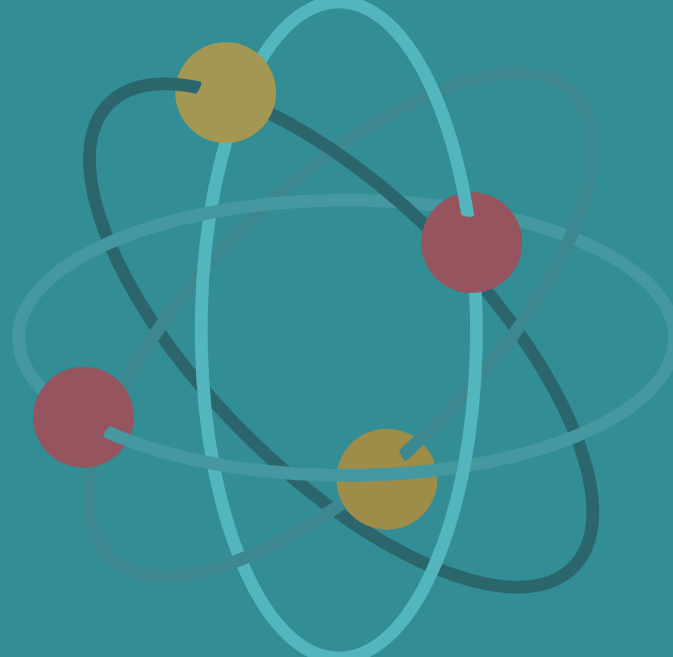

HOW TO GET A STUDENT ID CARD?



1. A student has to pay 22 PLN for the card at the cash desk (polish name: *kasy*) in the Rector's Office building at the ground floor.

2. Then a student has to go to the respective faculty Dean's Office with the receipt of payment and a photo, asking for issuing a student card.
