Admission requirements	<p>Once the students receive their selection e-mail, they will be provided with all the information about their registration and they will be required to provide the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• National Identity Document or Passport (valid for the whole period of their stay)</li><li>• Evidence of B1 Spanish language level (diploma)</li><li>• Medical insurance, including repatriation and international medical evacuation costs (valid for the whole period of their stay)</li><li>• Learning Agreement filled in with the courses to be undertaken at our university. Find more information about available courses in the UVa official <a href="#">catalogue</a>.</li></ul> <p>Once the documents have been examined and validated, the student will be admitted and will receive his/her Acceptance Letter.</p>	







## PRACTICAL INFORMATION

<p><b>Accommodation</b></p>	<p>UVa offers support to students in their search for accommodation before their arrival based on their preferences. It is recommended to use this service in order to avoid unwanted situations.</p> <p>The approximate rental cost for a room in a shared flat/apartment is 250-300€ per month.</p>	
<p><b>Living expenses</b></p>	<p>Aprox. 350-400€/month.</p>	
<p><b>Immigration procedures</b></p>	<p><b>A. EU citizens:</b> they must go to the Police Station to register their stay.</p> <p><b>B. Citizens from outside the European Union:</b> they must contact the Spanish embassy located at their countries of residence to obtain a student visa. In case their stay is longer than 6 months, they must go to the Police Station and apply for their “<i>Tarjeta de Identidad de Extranjero (TIE)</i>”.</p>	
<p><b>Insurance</b></p>		<p>For their temporary stay in Spain, students from the EU must get the <b>European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)</b> before leaving their countries.</p> <p>All exchange students/professors/staff visiting Universidad de Valladolid in the framework of any international mobility programme or bilateral agreement are required to have an <b>insurance policy</b> covering the following eventualities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Accident</li> <li>• Illness (international medical evacuation inclusive)</li> <li>• Repatriation in case of death</li> <li>• Health insurance (if not eligible for a EHIC)</li> </ul> <p>The students/staff will present the insurance policy upon their arrival. The mentioned policy (or its corresponding official translation) is accepted in any of the following languages: Spanish (preferably), English, French, Italian and Portuguese.</p> <p>In case they do not have an insurance policy that covers the mentioned eventualities, Universidad de Valladolid offers the possibility of contracting a policy covering their complete period of mobility, regardless of its duration.</p>
