Nominations have to be sent by e-mail to international_in@uphf.fr with the following information:

- Student's last and first name, Gender
- Study level (diploma and type), Field of study in the home university, Wished training at UPHF or ISCED code
- Language of instruction (French or English)
- E-mail address

Students will receive an e-mail after nomination including the application procedure. Following elements will be asked:

- The [UPHF Application Form](#) completed and signed
- A copy of university exam results of the last two years
- Certificate of student registration at home institution
- Proof of your level of French by your home institution
- A photocopy of a valid passport if students require a visa for their studies or ID card
- Learning agreement

Academic Calendar

From August 31st , to July 02

The academic year is divided into two semesters:

***Autumn semester** from September to December, January or February (depending on the faculty).

***Spring semester** from January or February to June or July (depending on the faculty) including the teaching and examination periods.

Each faculty determines its own teaching and examination periods.

Integration and welcome days

International exchange students are strongly recommended to attend the free of charge Integration Seminar taking place at the end of August (for winter semester and full year) and at the beginning of January (for spring semester).

Program of these integration days: registration, practical information, meetings with students and faculties representatives, discovery of Valenciennes city center and UPHF Campus sites, integration activities (welcome cocktail reception, restaurant, bowling, etc.).

In addition to integration days, the International Office organizes free of charge cultural and sport activities every month from September to April.

Other Information

FEES	For international exchange students: no fees for tuition, registration, examination and access to facilities such as laboratories, libraries or language centers. For double degree or degree students only : CVEC fees of 91€*.
ACCOMMODATION	Accommodation available for international students at 4 halls of residence. Prices wave from 207€ up to 575€* per month depending on the size and the equipment of the room. The application for accommodation is included in the UPHF application form.
HEALTH SYSTEM	The EEA members are covered by their European Health Insurance Card. However, for non EEA members, it is compulsory to be affiliated with the "Caisse primaire d'assurance maladie" (social health security scheme for students) in France. Link: https://www.ameli.fr/assure/english-pages
LANGUAGE SUPPORT	Summer school prior to the start of classes: Intensive training sessions in French organized by the International Academy located in Lille (50 km distance, accessible by train), two weeks beginning mid-August (60hours, 600€). The UPHF offers free attendance for international students under the Erasmus+ program. Details: http://www.cue-lillenorddefrance.fr/?q=international_academy_en During the year: French courses are offered (free of charge) by UPHF during the whole academic year (intermediate and advanced levels).
